Wayne iXPay 2 – Hardware & Software Updates Hybrid Card Reader (P96) & Keypad (SPM2.5 v2)

DFS partners:

We have the following hardware and software updates for your consideration:

- i.* To comply with latest PCI standards for enhanced security, we are introducing a new Hybrid (Contact Chip + MSR) Card Reader – the P96. This is in adherence to the expiry of PCI PTS v5.x components 30 April 2027
- ii.* To proactively manage uncertainties and supply chain disruptions globally – we are introducing a refreshed keypad – SPM2.5 v2, as a successor to the SPM2.5. The refreshed keypad has minor changes on a hardware sub-component level only, resulting in it retaining the same PCI PTS compliance and EMV L3 certification aspects of its predecessor SPM2.5.
- iii.* To support the above-mentioned components, it is required to upgrade the iXPay2 Payment software to 3.1.226.xxx & above. For more details, please refer to the external release notes shared by DFS third party or your DFS Account Manager.

Note: DFS Wayne L3 certification package will contain P96 paperwork such as EMV L1, TQM, and PCI approvals. The P96 will also be listed and is part of DFS Wayne iX Family letter calling out the specifics. You can consider P96 paperwork details for all new EMV L3 certifications along with the supported software version, where existing EMV L3 certifications remain unimpacted.

It is important to note that the updates (software & hardware) mentioned in this bulletin/document **do not impact any existing EMV L3 certifications** and is covered under the same Wayne family of EMV devices.

We recommend that you update simulators in your lab with the above software version & hardware components for any acceptance tests (UAT or integration) you intend to perform.

Please note that we plan to release all the above-mentioned updates (software & hardware) to our factory (production) by **Q1, 2027**.
